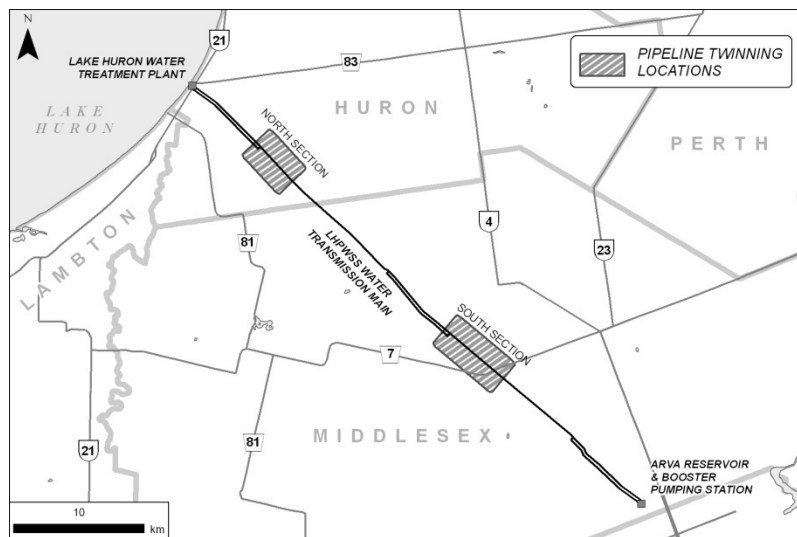

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2  
CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE LAKE HURON PRIMARY WATER  
TRANSMISSION MAIN TWINNING**

Through the master planning process, the Lake Huron Primary Water Supply System has identified that twinning of additional segments of the 1200 mm transmission main is required. This is in order to ensure the efficient long term operation of the Lake Huron Primary Water Supply System. This project is being conducted under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for Municipal Water and Wastewater Projects (Municipal Engineer's Association, June 2007).



Under this process, agency and public input is invited for incorporation into the planning and design of this project. A **second** Public Information Centre will be held on **Wednesday February 2, 2011 from 7:00pm - 9:00pm at the North Middlesex District Community Centre** (224 McLeod St, Parkhill) to present the preferred study alternative and to obtain public and agency input on the project. This meeting will have a formal presentation starting at 7:30pm. Representatives from LHPWSS and the project's consulting team will be available to answer questions and discuss the study.
